Data may also be shared with the Higher Education Statistics Agency and UCAS (or similar or replacement bodies. Students can also choose to share this information with future employers and other educational establishments*
- 3. The information will be stored securely and confidentially on the PebblePad and/or UWE secure host server and will be destroyed after 6 years from completion of the award.*
- 4. Where information is used in public reports, all published information will be anonymous.*
- 5. Participants are free to withdraw from the award at any point of the process when their contribution will be deleted from the data set, unless they agree to it being kept.*
